17/87 Minutes of the Previous Meeting

It was proposed by P Ransome and seconded by P Richards that the Minutes of the Meeting held on 1November 2017 were a true record. This was agreed and the Minutes were signed by the Chairman.

# 17/88 Matters Arising

Defibrillators - the replacement batteries and two cabinets had now been delivered. The batteries had been installed and new cupboards fitted to Llangennith Parish Hall and Burry Green Chapel. The electrician had fitted the new cabinet to Llanmadoc Village Shop and would be fitting the one at the Britannia later this week. The batteries for these two would be fitted when necessary.

# 17/89 Highways

The Clerk reported as follows:

Flooding between Northill Farm and Cheriton - Clerk is chasing Highways for an update.

S Parry had sent in a report as follows: .

Work Done included LG15 Harding's Down - new gate installed, old locked gate now open, new signs added; LM4 Cwm Ivy woods - low branches cut back; LG35 The Cot - replace stile with gate, LG14 New stile to Bremmel Cottage and trees cut on community field.

Work Planned included CH5 - contact owner re fence: LG2/3 - new stiles, waymarking Burry Head; LG9 - new stiles Burry Head; LM22 Youth camp - extra signs and waymarks to prevent wandering off the path - in job list; LM21 Lagadranta bridge to be repaired with longer sleepers but useable at present; CH1 Stone Lane Landimore - replace stile with gate; LG23 Broughton - sign clearance; LG24 Cock Street Farm - replace broken sign, clear round gate; LG30 Hillend Burrows - clear correct legal line of western end of path.

Work outstanding included CH1 Stembridge - install gates, clearance, levelling of surface site meeting still needed; LM6 - Surface/drainage improvements; LG35/36 Western House legal line of path to be opened; LM11 Phillestone - waymarking improvements, some clearance.

Well Park/Llanmadoc Hill - consultation period now over, some objections received so order may have to be restarted.

S Parry is happy to do a brief training/risk assessment on waymarking etc. Agreed that the Clerk would ask Steve Parry to arrange this directly with Steve Rimell and Jonathan Bale.

### **17/91 Finance**

Requests had been received from Llangennith Parish Hall and Llanmadoc and Cheriton Gardeners for help with the provision of a Christmas tree in each village. It was agreed to pay Gower Timber direct for the Llangennith tree and to contribute £100 towards the tree in Llanmadoc. (S Rimell & J Bale declared an interest in respect of Llangennith's tree)

A request for assistance with church wall repairs had been received from St Cenydd's Church. Their magazine account was currently quite healthy. It was agreed to contribute £750 this year. The Council would consider sponsoring the magazine once they had details MW of this.
