**WATER** A couple of us have had a go at tidying the Well area in Llangennith; we have tried to get a balance between it being accessible but not too formalised. Swansea CC workmen came out the day after and made a temporary solution to the overflow of water near the well. The culvert here is broken and requires a repair, the workmen suggested a more permanent solution, cutting back the point of the Green and putting in a new gully; we will explore this with Swansea. They also reported clearing drains at Kyfts Lane and Muzzard which we hope will solve the recent flooding concerns here. It appears that the flood between Northill Farm and Cheriton is the subject of ongoing discussions towards reaching a satisfactory outcome.

**Precept** The precept, the amount of money we ask of Swansea to spend in our community, will remain again this year at £7,250. Our expenditure was high this year through us needing to answer an objection to our land registration application; the objection was later withdrawn. Although some of the costs to the Council continue to increase, we expect to be able to maintain our same budget figure for the year ahead. There is the possibility of an election in 2017 for which we have to allow an additional sum of money.
