Land Registration

It has been a rather slow process but we are pleased to record that the Land Registry has recognised the Community Council's ownership of the Greens in Llanmadoc, (Church Green, Quoits Green, Catchpole, Rattle Street and Rhiwlas). Some long-standing accesses have now been included on the documentation. The Greens remain subject to Commons rights.

The title of land which we own is around the Village Hall is slightly different and we did not include that area with our application but may make another application in the future. This is the third time the Council has applied for registration, we are pleased that our ownership has, this time, been ratified. The Community Council has felt it important to register the land to avoid any future disputes.
