Defibrillator Contribution. The Community Council were very grateful to receive a donation of £400 from Llangennith Manors as a significant contribution towards replacing the batteries in the Council's Defibrillators in our Villages (total cost £800). Some of the metal cabinets have not lasted so well in our exposed location, Cardiac Science are supplying four stainless steel boxes to replace the rusted ones, they be fitted in the near future.
