On 2<sup>nd</sup> November, we carried out the common land inspection, all the Councillors were present and the rain held off until we got to Bury Green, so we were lucky! We highlighted the following problems: Llanmadoc – benches need sprucing up in the spring (cleaning and painting), fire break needs attention behind the Community Hall. Bury Green – benches need cleaning in the spring and one needs repairing now, native Welsh daffodils will be planted next summer on the periphery of the green, at the entrance to the village, to hopefully bloom from the following spring. The Council are also aware that the benches in Llangennith and Landimore will need cleaning and painting in spring.

The Community Council have agreed to contribute towards the Christmas trees at both Llangennith and Llanmadoc and are awaiting a request from Burry Green. These should certainly make the villages feel Christmassy.

Although I report potholes to the highways department on a monthly basis, I would like to remind everyone that anyone can do this on line, it is just a straightforward form to fill in, giving the relevant details and position of the pothole. The City and County of Swansea commitment is '**Report a pothole and we'll aim to fix it within 48 hours of you reporting it (weather permitting)**'.
