AGM:

This month (June 21) we were able to physically meet in Llangennith Hall and therefore held our AGM. Councillor David Gibbs was unanimously voted in as Chairperson and Councillor Jonathan Bale was unanimously voted in as Vice Chairperson. Congratulations to them both.

Outgoing Chairpersons report:

“When the last Chairman’s report was delivered in spring 2019, none of us could anticipate how life would change before the next Chairman’s report. This report is for a period of just over two years. For the majority of the first year the Community Council carried on functioning in the same ways as it had done for a number of years. Each month we discussed pot holes, blocked footpaths, planning applications, common land and which good causes would benefit from a donation from us.

Of course, a big change occurred as the pandemic took hold of all our lives. Planning applications dried up, pot holes seemed to go unfilled and visitors stayed away. We have continued to support the community whenever we can, including financial help with Christmas trees, Parish Magazine, grant requests and continued to carry out jobs such as grass cutting and pond clearance. Unfortunately, we were unable to bring to fruition the ‘Keep Wales Tidy’ garden project, but hopefully another community has benefited instead.

We have been unable to meet in person, but Zoom has come to our rescue. The variances of the electronic airways, has meant that unfortunately not all members have been able to participate in the meetings, or only by telephone, which at times has seemed to give the meeting a slightly one sided feel.

On a sad note, a former Community Councillor and Chairman, Randolph Jenkins, passed away. He will be remembered by many in our community.

Probably the biggest challenge to the Community Council over the past year, has been the identification of a large number of Ash trees needing felling on land either owned by or leased to, the Community Council. What could have been a difficult situation financially for us was alleviated by generous donations from Llangennith Manors and Cllr Richard Lewis. I would like to thank them personally for these donations.

Finally I would like to thank my fellow Councillors and Jayne, our clerk, for their support and help over the past months”.
