**Gower Macmillan Mighty Hike Event:**

The event attracts many participants, the start will be staggered over a 3 hour period in order to reduce build up in local areas.

**Notice Board – Llangennith:**

Last month, the Community Council notice board/cabinet sustained some damage in the windy weather, the door was ripped open and all the information disappeared from it. The door was damaged and it would not lock. A repair has been undertaken and the lock barrel needed replacing, a local resident Robin Bevan has replaced and repaired the lock and the cabinet is now back up and running. Robin refused remuneration for this, the Community Councillors would like to thank him for his help.

**Llanmadoc Parking:**

We have received the following reply from Cllr Richard Lewis regarding the parking issue in Llanmadoc; "Sadly, there is very little the Council can do about this, as it does need to be enforced by the Police. As you mentioned in your email, it is recommended that these incidents are recorded via 101. The Police can action accordingly, and it will build up a record of the problem." Therefore the Community Councillors are advising that all incidents of dangerous or obstructive parking are reported by local residents on 101.

**Freedom of Information request:**

The Community Council have received a freedom of information request regarding ash dieback, asking for correspondence issued to private households and details of the extent of the disease to the trees, we will answer this as appropriate, although all the information is already in the public domain. We will refer them to the highways department of The City and County of Swansea who requested the work be carried out.
